Key role in the economy: economic growth and local development

- Direct impact through local contracting and community investment
- <u>Indirect Impact</u>: For each Dollar of Mining GDP, an additional 0.7 Dollars in GDP is generated in other sectors.



- Education projects (infrastructure) and educational collaborative agreements.
- Strengthening (Training) of teachers, principals and scholars.
- Contribution to improve the level of schooling of children and young people.
- Scholarship programs, internship jobs and specialties in high schools.



- Sustainable water management: R & D for efficient use / water recirculation / minimize aquifer use / water balance / integrated water management plan
- Infrastructure: rural potable water supply systems / social investment axis / construction of desalination plants.



- It encourages Energy Efficiency throughout the production chain and at all levels of the organization.


